#### **1. Once Upon a Time in the City of New York**

Pilot: An attorney (Linda Hamilton) in New York is rescued by Vincent (Ron Perlman) who lives in a tunnel community beneath the city.

#### **2. Terrible Savior**

Broadcast: October 2, 1987

Writer: George R.R. Martin

Catherine fears Vincent is responsible for the maulings of thugs on the subway.

#### **3. Siege**

Broadcast: October 9, 1987

Writer: David Peckinpah

Vincent suffers heartbreak when Catherine begins to fall for wealthy bachelor Elliot Burch (Edward Albert).

#### **4. No Way Down**

Broadcast: October 16, 1987

Writer: James Crocker

Cathy's search for a witness leads her into a gang war. Vincent is captured by the Silks.

#### **5. Masques**

Broadcast: October 30, 1987

Writer: George R.R. Martin

An Irish novelist's (Caitlin O'Heany) visit brings admiring Vincent to a costume party, but her enemies endanger Catherine.

#### **6. Beast Within**

Broadcast: November 6, 1987

Writer: Andrew Laskos

Vincent's childhood friend, a mobster just out of jail, tries to take over a local longshoreman's union.

#### **7. Nor Iron Bars a Cage**

Broadcast: November 13, 1987

Writers: Alex Gansa, Howard Gordon, Ron Perlman

Catherine considers a job on Rhode Island. Vincent is captured by two anthropology scientists.

#### **8. Song of Orpheus**

Broadcast: November 20, 1987

Writers: Alex Gansa, Howard Gordon

Father's tries to contact an old flame and is arrested on suspicion of murder.

#### **9. Dark Spirit**

Broadcast: November 27, 1987

Writer: Robin Bernheim

Cathy's investigation of a businessman's poisoning leads to voodoo and an expert (Cliff De Young).

#### **10. A Children's Story**

Broadcast: December 14, 1987

Writer: B. F. Barnett

Catherine investigates a respected orphanage after information from Vincent makes her suspicious.

#### **11. An Impossible Silence**

Broadcast: December 18, 1987

Writers: Howard Gordon, Alex Gansa

A deaf tunnel dweller (Terrylene) witnesses a murder and realizes a man is being wrongly accused.

#### **12. Shades of Grey**

Broadcast: January 8, 1988

Writers: George R.R. Martin, David Peckinpah

Cathy turns to Elliot Burch for help when Vincent and Father are trapped by a cave-in.

### **13. China Moon**

Broadcast: January 15, 1988

Writer: Cynthia Benjamin

An arranged marriage and a tong war threaten the love of a Chinatown couple (Rosalind Chao, Dennis Dun).

### **14. The Alchemist**

Broadcast: January 22, 1988

Writer: Richard Setlowe

Vincent helps Catherine search for the source of a deadly hallucinogen grown by Paracelsus.

### **15. Temptation**

Broadcast: February 5, 1988

Writer: David Peckinpah

Joe falls in love with a corporate attorney, whose firm represents someone he is investigating.

### **16. Promises of Someday**

Broadcast: February 12, 1988

Writer: George R.R. Martin

A mysterious new attorney (Bruce Abbott) in Catherine's office turns out to be a long-lost tunnel dweller.

### **17. Down to a Sunless Sea**

Broadcast: February 19, 1988

Writer: Don Balluck

Vincent is uneasy when Catherine re-connects with a dying, former fiancé.

### **18. Fever**

Broadcast: February 26, 1988

Writers: Mark Cassutt, Michael Cassutt

Greed threatens the tunnel community when an ancient, treasure-laden ship is discovered Below.

### **19. Everything Is Everything**

Broadcast: March 4, 1988

Writer: Virginia Aldridge

Catherine helps a gypsy boy whose family has declared him outcast for a crime his father allegedly committed.

### **20. To Reign in Hell**

Broadcast: March 18, 1988

Writers: Howard Gordon, Alex Gansa

Paracelsus kidnaps Catherine to lure Vincent and kill him.

### **21. Ozymandias**

Broadcast: April 1, 1988

Writer: George R.R. Martin

Elliot Burch's construction of a massive skyscraper threatens the existence of the tunnel world and its painted walls.

### **22. A Happy Life**

Broadcast: April 8, 1988

Writer: Ron Koslow

Catherine questions her emotional life on the 20th anniversary of her mother's death.

## **Season 2**

### **23. Chamber Music**

Broadcast: November 18, 1988

Writer: Ron Koslow

Vincent and Catherine try to help a former music prodigy of the tunnel world, now an addict. (guest: Theodore Bikel).

### **24. Remember Love**

Broadcast: November 25, 1988

Writer: Virginia Aldridge

Forced to decline a trip with Catherine because of the risk, Vincent dreams about what everyone's lives would be like without him.

### **25. Ashes, Ashes**

Broadcast: December 2, 1988

Writers: Durrell Royce Crays, Roy Dotrice

A defecting Russian sailor (Adrian Paul) brings a lethal virus into the Tunnels.

### **26. Dead of Winter**

Broadcast: December 9, 1988

Writer: George R.R. Martin

Paracelsus plans revenge and mayhem during Catherine's first Winterfest.

### **27. God Bless the Child**

Broadcast: December 16, 1988

Writers: Alex Gansa, Howard Gordon

Catherine brings a pregnant prostitute to the tunnels who falls in love with Vincent.

### **28. Sticks and Stones**

Broadcast: January 6, 1989

Writers: Alex Gansa, Howard Gordon

Laura (Terrylene) joins a violent gang of deaf people under investigation by the DA.

### **29. A Fair and Perfect Knight**

Broadcast: January 13, 1989

Writer: P.K. Simonds, Jr

A Tunnel graduate falls in love with Catherine as she helps him prepare for his first year of university.

### **30. Labyrinths**

Broadcast: January 20, 1989

Writers: Alex Gansa, Howard Gordon

A teenager (Jonathan Ward) in Catherine's building follows her into the tunnels, threatening its secret existence.

### **31. Brothers**

Broadcast: February 3, 1989

Writer: George R.R. Martin

Devin returns, bringing a badly-disfigured man to the tunnel world.

### **32. A Gentle Rain**

Broadcast: February 17, 1989

Writers: M.M. Shelly Moore, Linda Campanelli

Catherine discovers that a tunnel dweller is wanted on an outstanding warrant for manslaughter (guest: Piper Laurie).

### **33. The Outsiders**

Broadcast: February 24, 1989

Writers: Michael Berlin, Alex Gansa, Howard Gordon

A violent group of outsiders invade the tunnels and force Vincent to deal with them.

### **34. Orphans**

Broadcast: March 6, 1989

Writers: Alex Gansa, Howard Gordon

Catherine seeks sanctuary and healing with Vincent in the tunnel world when her father dies.

### **35. Arabesque**

Broadcast: March 13, 1989

Writer: Virginia Aldridge

Vincent's first love (Elyssa Davalos) returns to the tunnels, seeking sanctuary from an international arms dealer.

### **36. When the Bluebird Sings**

Writers: Robert John Guttke, George R.R. Martin  
Catherine is befriended by a young painter (Franc Luz), believed dead.

### **37. The Watcher**

Broadcast: April 7, 1989

Writers: M.M. Shelly Moore, Linda Campanelli

Catherine is endangered by a voyeur who has seen Vincent, on their second anniversary.

### **38. A Distant Shore**

Broadcast: April 14, 1989

Writer: Marie Therese Squerciatti

Catherine goes to Los Angeles to investigate a tape-counterfeiting case, after a key witness is murdered.

### **39. Trial**

Broadcast: April 21, 1989

Writers: Howard Gordon, Alex Gansa

Catherine, while prosecuting a Wall Street businessman accused of beating his son to death, discovers he also victimized his wife and daughter.

### **40. A Kingdom by the Sea**

Broadcast: April 28, 1989

Writer: George R.R. Martin

Elliot Burch asks Catherine for help when the CIA investigates him for arms smuggling and an international group of thugs kills his father.

#### **41. The Hollow Men**

Broadcast: May 5, 1989

Writers: Andrew Laskos, P.K. Simonds, Jr.

Vincent witnesses the murder of a prostitute and Catherine investigates two wealthy young men she believes responsible for a string of similar murders.

#### **42. What Rough Beast (Part 1)**

Broadcast: May 12, 1989

Writers: Alex Gansa, Howard Gordon, George R.R. Martin

Acting on a tip, a reporter investigates Catherine's cases and threatens to expose Vincent's involvement.

#### **43. Ceremony of Innocence (Part 2)**

Broadcast: May 19, 1989

Writers: George R.R. Martin, Howard Gordon, Alex Gansa

Paracelsus kills the reporter and impersonates Father to manipulate Vincent with hints about his parentage.

#### **44. The Rest Is Silence (Part 3)**

Broadcast: June 2, 1989

Writers: J. Larry Carroll, David Bennett Carren  
Vincent is nursed by Catherine after he collapses in her apartment. He retreats into the deep tunnels and Catherine goes after him.

### **Season 3**

#### **45. Though Lovers Be Lost (Part 1 &2)**

Broadcast: December 12, 1989

Writers: Alex Gansa, Howard Gordon

Joe is injured in a blast that kills a gang witness. Catherine discovers she is pregnant with Vincent's child. The gang leader (Stephen McHattie) kidnaps Catherine with the Moreno's help. Vincent searches for Catherine but no longer feels their bond. He follows the child's heartbeat to her as she gives birth six months later. The child is taken by Gabriel and Catherine injected with a lethal drug. She dies in Vincent's arms and he carries her back to her apartment.

#### **46. Walk Slowly**

Broadcast: December 13, 1989

Writers: M. M. Shelley Moore, Linda Campanelli  
While Vincent grieves Catherine's death, Detective Diana Bennett (Jo Anderson) probes Catherine's murder at Joe's request. Moreno is killed by Vincent and shot. Joe becomes DA.

#### **47. Nevermore**

Broadcast: December 20, 1989

Writer: P. K. Simonds, Jr.

Vincent asks Elliott Burch to help him find Catherine's killer and her child.

#### **48. Snow**

Writer: George R. R. Martin

Vincent is recuperating from injuries. Gabriel hires an assassin to kill Vincent in the tunnels.

#### **49. Beggar's Comet**

Broadcast: January 3, 1990

Writer: George R. R. Martin

Vincent give Elliot Burch Snow's ring to investigate. Burch meets Vincent on a the Crystal Rose intending to betray him, but instead returning the ring to him. Gabriel explodes the boat, killing Burch and injuring Vincent.

#### **50. A Time to Heal**

Broadcast: January 10, 1990

Writers: Alex Gansa, Howard Gordon

Diana discovers a seriously injured Vincent at Catherine's grave and takes him to her apartment to recover.

#### **51. The Chimes at Midnight**

Broadcast: July 20, 1990

Writer: P. K. Simonds, Jr. Directed by Ron Perlman.

Diana is told that Vincent's son is ill and Vincent surrenders to Gabriel to help his ailing baby son.

#### **52. Invictus**

Broadcast: January 17, 1990

Writers: M. M. Shelley Moore, Linda Campanelli  
Diana uses her knowledge of Gabriels mansion to get Joe to invade it, while she and Father rescue Vincent and his infant son. She kills Gabriel with Catherine's gun.

### **53. In the Forests of the Night**

Broadcast: January 24, 1990

Writer: George R. R. Martin

Vincent destroys a drug warehouse after an addicted ex-music prodigy is shot and seeks sanctuary in the tunnels.

### **54. The Reckoning**

Broadcast: July 27, 1990

Writers: Alex Gansa, Howard Gordon

Father reunites with a former flame (Fionnula Flanagan). Diana stalks a serial killer who is targetting former tunnel dwellers.

### **55. Legacies**

Broadcast: August 3, 1990

Writers: Alex Gansa, Howard Gordon

The ex-tunnel dweller seeking to avenge his father's death in the tunnels, targets Father, the last of his victims. Diana helps Vincent rescue Father.
