How to create your folding, pocket-sized Beauty and the Beast Tribute Booklet

1) Colour print pages 1 and 2, as they appear, one on each side of a standard 8 X 10" piece of white paper (be sure they are aligned in the same direction). A slightly heavier paper stock is recommended.

2) Place the side with the faint dotted line in the middle upwards. Fold the page in half, joining the short sides. You'll now have a dotted line that goes halfway down the middle of the page. Cut that line through both sides of the fold. Then rotate the page and join the long edges, and fold the middle, on either side of the cut (#2).

With the fold and cut part on the top, and the open side to the bottom, grab the page at the ends on both sides of the cut, still folded (#3), and push them together, so that they meet in the middle and the pages form a four-pointed star (#4).

Now, fold all the quarter panels to the right so that the leaf edges all line up and there's a single crease to the left, like the spine of a book. Shift the leaves around until you get the cover of the booklet to the front and the '*Sort of like a dream*' panel on the back. This is the front part of the book.

Now open it up to the reverse side, which has 8 more panels, all facing the same way - downwards, like the cover. To close the book, form that star again and make the sides meet as above. They're not in any particular order for reading, except the front and back.
