
## **Festive Crocheted Links Garland**

Use any plain leftover yarn, in any plain colours, variegated, or mixed blends, or any yarn easy to crochet.

The pattern is simple. For links 3 inches/7.5cm long (6 inches/15cm) folded in half) and 1/2 inch/1.2cm wide,

- 1: Chain 20.
- 2. Slip stitch to join the ends.
- 3. Chain 1 and double crochet in each chain around (working right to left).

To ensure the link doesn't stretch and looks uniform, hook the yarn for the double crochet under the top and back loops (1 and 2 in the diagram) of the chain, above the lower loop (3) front to back. The opening will be close to where the following chain joins.



4. Slip stitch to join the double crochet row. Weave in ends.

When you do the second and following links, put the chain through the previous link before slip stitching to join it. Double crochet and join as for first link.

Make as many links as you need for your decoration.
