Vincent's Easy Fingerless Gloves

Supplies: 1 skein sport weight yarn, US H/8 (Can/UK6, Aus/NZ 5.0mm) crochet hook Abbreviations:

ch= chain; st= stitch; dc= double crochet; hdc= half double crochet; slst= slip stitch

Note: Since these gloves can be made any size, keep a record of how many ch st and rows you used. Total rows will be from 20-25 of each (rows 2 and 3)

- 1. Ch 28 (or enough even numbered chains to reach from an inch below the wrist to the bottom of the fingers on the palm side.
- 2. Hdc in third ch from hook then hdc across length, ch 3 turn
- 3. Dc in first hdc, dc across, ch 2 turn
- 4. Repeat rows 2 and 3 until width when vertical work (with crochet rows held at 90 degrees) is wide enough for hand.
- 5. Fold rectangle in half and on wrong side, slst down about 2 inches from top. along edge of crocheting. Tie off.
- 6. From bottom edge of glove, slst up to where thumb begins, leaving about 2 inches for thumb opening. Tie off.
- 7. For fingers, join gloves at top half way across with slst and tie off, and again half of each remaining space.
- 8. Turn right side out. Sew in loose ends. Gloves may be worn on either hand.
